The Albert Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City
collapsed into a pile of rubble and torn bodies after explosions ripped its supports from the foundation at approximately 9:02 am, Wednesday, April 19, 1995, the
second anniversary of the Waco massacre. Timothy
McVeigh, a Gulf War veteran has been arrested and
charged with the crime. James and Terry Nichols, brothers, have been arrested and charged with conspiracy to
build explosive devices at James' farm in Michigan.

The Truth About Militias

Words have meaning. There is a process which we may use to determine the specific meaning of Militia both in the language and under the Law. The 1971 edition of 'The Compact Edition of the Oxford English Dic-tionary' defines:

The first U.S. document in law is 'The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America'. It sets out the reasons and justifications for our separation from England and the Revolutionary War that followed. The document places the decision and the power in the hands of the people, and was clearly meant to be enforced by the Militia, a citizens army. That army, the Continental Army of the Republic won our Independence. The Declaration of Independence clearly states:

The Obelisk. Caduceus and Sun God Evolution

This column is for the education of the readers of Veritas. The intent is to expose the occut meanings of the symbols around us. Veritas, the Editors, and Jack Shepher, do not subscribe to these beliefs.

Note: symbolism is all around us; in our church, homes, TV, music, government, etc. and it is a language that you must study repeatedly to understand. Obelisks, as ancient historian Pliny (about 50 A.D.) observed, are sacred to the sun. This is similar to all such upright ancient structures such as the pyramids, a word from the Greek "pyr", meaning fire, as with a pyre of funeral fire (or a pyromaniac or pyrography). From obelisk, we get the symbol of light, in Latin "lux", on the name Luke (or Lukes). These obelisks, the symbol of the sun's light ray, all have a small four-sided pyramid on the top called the pyramidan which symbolizes the fiery head or end of the phallus. Many early obelisk forms are found in northern Europe. These monoliths are clearly and simply giant male phalli. This form is found in many ancient cities of the Roman Empire. They are everywhere, as all upright structures in architecture are indicative of the phallus, or index-finger denoting the "Fire", the aspiring fire, against the inclination of gravity, which was the first vialized idea, or Idol), worshipped magically and philosophically, the godlike godhead power. The many washerocoks, steeples or other spiral forms are signs of the ancient transformation of the oldest phallic religions through a revolution or evolution of religions. The phallic spire at the base, and the weatherock, called "abravata", a name coined by Basilloes, the Egyptian Gnostic, was at the top. From early Egypt, religion turned upward to the sun, the rooster is the bringer of the sun and in ancient mythology, le is pictured riding a chaniot with four white horses and carrying a large gold shield. The shield reflects the rising sun's light onto the moon which is the female symbol in our sky.

There are two serpents rotating around the center rol. On the left, the dark serpent rotates 31/2 times counter-fockwise and is the female, or lower hanging testicle (yes, do look and check, after this see "Gray's Anatomy", 1974 edition p. 1015; in print). On the right side, the white serpent rolles 31/2 times clockwise and is the male, or the higher testicle. The top of the caduceus shows a golden sun disc on white wings of purity.

A common fallacy about man's duty to man was repeated recently by a prominent layman at a religious conference. As an expression of our social responsibilities he suggested, "We are our brother's keep-

our social responsibilities he suggested, "we are our oromer a respect."

Although this interpretation of a scriptural sentence is widely accepted, it is without foundation in ethics and can lead to more quarrels than benefits. It derives from a misreading of the passage in the fourth chapter of Genesis about the murder of Abel by his brother Cain. When the two brothers were in a field, Cain rose up against Abel and slew him. Afterward the Lord said to Cain. "Where is Abel thy brother?" Not having the benefit of our modern enlightenment, he did not take the Fifth Amendment. He simply told a lie, "I know not." And then he countered with an evasive question, "Am I my brother's keeper?"


This was altogether irrelevant. The Lord was not demanding that he be his brother's keeper, but only that he shouldn't be his brother's weather.



In our bill of responsibilities, the first is not, as urged by sociological busybodies, that we shall be our brother's keepers, standing watch over them and poking our noses into their private concerns. The first responsibility is that we shall not shed their blood or do any other wrong against our fellow men.

If all the world's people were our brothers, and we were our brother's keepers, they would be also our keepers. We would be among the keept. In the slave societies of totalitarianism, from the Baltic Sea to the sad coasts of Siberia and China, everybody is required to be his brother's keeper - to maintain a sharp watch on him and to blow the whistle the minute he deviates from total obedience. Of course, such a way of life for America is not advocated by well-meaning people who tell us that our duty is to be our brother's keepers. Generous as why are in spriit, they have failed to draw clear distinctions between proper help and perpetual meddling. We have a duty to help the sick, the incapacitated, the very weak. But what our neighbors in general need is a large amount of being let along.

Constitution for the United States of America

We the People of the United States, in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defence, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States

Article I

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, and been seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.

Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including those bound to Service for a Term of Years, and excluding Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons. The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct. The Number of Representatives shall not exceed one for every thirty Thousand, but each State shall have at Least one Representative; and until such enumeration shall be made, the State of New Hampshire shall be entitled to chuse three, Massachusetts eight, Rhode-Island and Providence Plantations one, Connecticut five, New York six, New Jersey four, Pennsylvania eight, Delaware one, Maryland six, Virginia ten, North Carolina five, South Carolina five, and Georgia three.

The House of Representatives shall chuse their speaker and other Officers; and shall have the sole Power of Impeachment.

Section 3. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for six Years; and each Senator shall have one Vote. Immediately after they shall be assembled in Consequence of the first Election, they shall be divided as equally as may be into three Classes. The Seats of the Senators of the first Class shall be vacated at the Expiration of the second Year, of the second Class at the Expiration of the

fourth Year, and of the third Class at the Expiration of the sixth Year, so that one third may be chosen every second Year; and if Vacancies happen by Resignation, or otherwise, during the Recess of the Legislature of any State, the Executive thereof may make temporary Appointments until the next Meeting of the Legislature, which shall then fill such Vacancies.

No Person shall be a Senator who shall not have attained to the Age of thirty Years, and been nine Years a Citizen of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State for which he shall be chosen.

The Vice President of the United States shall be President of the Senate, but shall have no Vote.

The Vice President of the United States shall be President of the Senate, but shall have no Vote, unless they be equally divided.

The Senate shall chuse their other Officers, and also a President pro tempore, in the Absence of the Vice President, or when he shall exercise the Office of President of the United States.

The Senate shall have the sole Power to try all Impeachments. When sitting for that Purpose, they shall be on Oath or Affirmation. When the President of the United States is tried, the Chief Justice shell preside: And no Person shall be convicted without the Concurrence of two thirds of

Justice shall preside: Anu for reson summer to the Members present.

Judgment in Cases of Impeachment shall not extend further than to removal from Office, and disqualification to hold and enjoy any Office of honor, Trust or Profit under the United States; but the Party convicted shall nevertheless be liable and subject to Indictment, Trial, Judgment and Punishment, according to law.

Section 4. The Times, Places and Manner of holding Elections for Senators and Representatives, shall be prescribed in each State by the Legislature thereof; but the Congress may at any time by Law make or alter such Regulations, except as to the Places of chusing Senators. The Congress shall assemble at least once in every Year, and such Meeting shall be on the first Monday in December, unless they shall by Law appoint a different Day.

Section 5. Each House shall be the Judge of the Elections, Returns and Qualifications of its own Members, and a Majority of each shall constitute a Quorum to do Business; but a smaller Number may adjourn from day to day, and may be authorized to compel the Attendance of absent Members, in such Manner, and under such Penalties as each House may provide. Each House may determine the Rules of its Proceedings, punish its Members for disorderly Behaviour, and, with the Concurrence of two thirds, expel a Member.

Each House shall keep a Journal of its Proceedings, and from time to time publish the same excepting such Parts as may in their Judgment require Secrecy; and the Yeas and Nays of the Members of either House on any question shall, at the Desire of one fifth of those Present, be

Neither House, during the Session of Congress, shall, without the Consent of the other, adjourn for more than three days, nor to any other place than that in which the two Houses shall be sitting.

Section 6. The Senators and Representatives shall receive a Compensation for their Services, to be ascertained by Law, and paid out of the Treasury of the United States. They shall in all Cases, except Treason, Felony and Breach of the Peace, be privileged from Arrest during their Attendance at the Session of their respective Houses, and in going to and returning from the same; and for any Speech or Debate in either House, they shall not be questioned in any other Place. No Senator or Representative shall, during the Time for which he was elected, be appointed to any civil Office under the Authority of the United States, which shall have been created, or the Emoluments whereof shall have been encreased during such time; and no Person holding any Office under the United States, shall be a Member of either House during his Continuance in Office

Office.

Section 7. All Bills for raising Revenue shall originate in the House of Representatives; but the Senate may propose or concur with Amendments as on the other Bills.

Every Bill which shall have passed the House of Representatives and the Senate, shall, before it become a Law, be presented to the President of the United States; If he approve he shall signif, but if not he shall return it, with his Objections to that House in which it shall have originated, who shall enter the Objections at large on their Journal, and proceed to reconsider it. If after such Reconsideration two thirds of that Houses shall agree to pass the Bill, it shall be sent, together with the Objections, to the other House, by which it shall likewise be reconsidered, and if approved by two thirds of that House, it shall become a Law. But in all such Cases the Votes of both Houses shall be determined by Yeas and Nays, and the Names of the Persons voting for and against the Bill shall be entered on the Journal of each House respectively. If any Bill shall not be returned by the President within ten Days (Sundays excepted) after it shall have been presented to him, the Same shall be a Law, in like Manner as if he had signed it unless the Congress by their Adjournment prevent its Return, in which Case it shall not be Law.

To provide and maintain a Navy;

To make rules for the Government and Regulation of the land and naval Forces;

To provide for calling forth the Militia to execute the Laws of the Union, suppress Insurrections and repel Invasions;

To provide for organizing, arming, and disciplining, the Militia, and for governing such Part of them as may be employed in the Service of the United States, reserving to the States respectively, the Appointment of the Officers, and the Authority of training the Militia according to the discipline prescribed by Congress;

To exercise exclusive Legislation in all Cases whatsoever, over such District (not exceeding en Miles source), as may, by Cession of particular States, and the Acceptance of Congress.

To exercise exclusive Legislation in all Cases whatsoever, over such District (not exceeding ten Miles square), as may, by Cession of particular States, and the Acceptance of Congress, become the Seat of the Government of the United States, and to exercise like Authority over all Places purchased by the consent of the Legislature of the State in which the Same shall be for the Erection of Forts, Magazines, Arsenals, dock-Yards, and other needful Buildings;—And To make all Laws which shall be necessary and proper for carrying into Execution the foregoing Powers, and all other Powers vested by this Constitution in the Government of the United States, or in any Department or Officer thereof.

Section 9. The Migration or Importation of such Persons as any of the States now existing shall think proper to admit, shall not be prohibited by the Congress prior to the Year one thousand eight hundred and eight, but a Tax or duty may be imposed on such Importation, not exceeding ten dollars for each Person.

The Privilege of the Writ of Habeas Corpus shall not be suspended, unless when in Cases of Rebellion or Invasion the public Safety may require it.

No Bill of Attainder or ex post facto Law shall be passed.

No Capitation, or other direct, Tax shall be laid, unless in Proportion to the Census or Enumeration herein before directed to be taken.

No Tax or Duty shall be laid on Articles exported from any State.

No preference shall be given by any Regulation of Commerce or Revenue to the Ports of one State over those of another: nor shall Vessels bound to, or from, one State, be obliged to enter, clear, or pay Duties in another.

Article II

Section 1. The executive Power shall be vested in a President of the United States of America. He shall hold his Office during the Term of four Years, and, together with the Vice President, chosen for the same term, be elected, as follows.

Each State shall appoint, in such Manner as the Legislature thereof may direct, a Number of Electors, caugal to the whole Number of Senators and Representatives to which the State may be entitled in the Congress: but no Senator or Representative, or Person holding an Office of Trust or Profit under the United States, shall be appointed an Elector.

The Electors shall meet in their respective States, and vote by Ballot for two Persons, of whom one at least shall not be an Inhabitant of the same State with themselves. And they shall make a List of all the Persons voted for, and of the Number of Votes for each; which List they shall sign and certify, and transmit sealed to the Seat of the Government of the United States, directed to the President of the Senates thall, in the Presence of the Senate and House of Representatives, open all the Certificates, and the Votes shall be the President, if such number be a Majority of the whole Number of Electors appointed; and if there be more than one who have such Majority, and have an equal Number of Votes, then the House of Representatives shall immediately chuse by Ballot one of them for President: and if no Person have a Majority, then from the five highest on the List the said House shall in like manner chuse the President. But in chusing the President, the Votes shall be taken by States, the Representation from each State having one Vote; A quorum for this Purpose shall consist of a Member or Members from two thirds of the States, and a majority of all the States shall be necessary to a Choice. In every Case, after the Choice of the President, the Person having the greatest Number of Votes of the Electors shall be the Vice President, the Person having the greatest Number of Votes of the Electors shall be the Vice President.

Before he enter on the Execution of his Office, he shall take the following Oath or Affirma-tion:—"I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will faithfully execute the Office of President of the United States, and will to the best of my Ability, preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of the United States

Section 2. The President shall be Commander in Chief of the Army and Navy of the United States, and of the Militia of the several States, when called into the actual Service of the United States; he may require the Opinion, in writing, of the principal Officer in each of the executive Departments, upon any Subject relating to the Duties of their respective Offices, and he shall have Power to grant Reprieves and Pardons for Offences against the United States, except in Cases of Impeachment.

He shall have Power, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Senate, to make Treaties, provided two thirds of the Senators present concur, and he shall nominate, and by and with the Advice and Consent of the Senate, shall appoint Ambassadors, other public Ministers and Consuls, Judges of the supreme Court, and all other Officers of the United States, whose Appointments are not herein otherwise provided for, and which shall be established by Law: but Congress may by Law west the Appointment of such inferior Officers, as they think proper, in the President alone, in the Courts of Law, or in the Heads of Departments.

The President shall have Power to fill up all Vacancies that may happen during the Recess of the Senate, by granting Commissions which shall expire at the End of their next Session.

Section 3. He shall from time to time give to the Congress Information of the State of the Union, section 3. He shall from time to time give to the Congress information of the State of the Unint, and recommend to their Consideration such Measures as he shall judge necessary and expedient; he may, on extraordinary Occasions, convene both Houses, or either of them, and in Case of Disagreement between them, with Respect to the Time of Adjournment, he may adjourn them to such Time as he shall think proper; he shall receive Ambassadors and other public Ministers; he shall take Care that the Laws be faithfully executed, and shall Commission all the Officers of the

Section 4. The President, Vice President and all civil Officers of the United States, shall be removed from Office on Impeachment for, and Conviction of, Treason, Bribery, or other High Crimes and Misdemeanors.

Article III

Section 1. The judicial Power of the United States, shall be vested in one supreme Court, and in such inferior Courts as the Congress may from time to time ordain and establish. The Judges, both of the supreme and inferior Courts, shall hold their Offices during good Behaviour, and shall, at stated Times, receive for their Services, a Compensation, which shall not be diminished during their Continuance in Office.

Section 2. The judicial Power shall extend to all Cases, in Law and Equity, arising under this Constitution, the Laws of the United States, and Treaties made, or which shall be made, under their Authority;—to all Cases affecting Ambassadors, other public Ministers and Consuls - to all cases of admiralty and maritime Jurisdiction;—to Controversies between two or more States; between a State and Citizens of another State;—between Citizens of different States;—between Citizens of the same State claiming Lands under Grants of different States, and between a State, or the Citizens thereof, and foreign States, Citizens or Subjects.

In all Cases affecting Ambassadors, other public Ministers and Consuls, and those in which a State shall be Party, the supreme Court shall have original Jurisdiction. In all the other Cases before mentioned, the supreme Court shall have original Jurisdiction, both as to Law and Fact, with such Exceptions, and under such Regulations as the Congress shall make.

The Trial of all Crimes, except in Cases of Impeachment, shall be by Jury; and such Trial shall be held in the State where the said Crimes shall have been committed; but when not committed within any State, the Trial shall be at such Place or Places as the Congress may by Law have directed.

Section 3. Treason against the United States, shall consist only in levying War against them, or in adhering to their Enemies, giving them Aid and Comfort. No Persons shall be convicted of Treason unless on the Testimony of two Witnesses to the same overt Act, or on Confession in open Court.

Section 1. Full Faith and Credit shall be given in each State to the public Acts, Records, and judicial Proceedings of every other State. And the Congress may by general Laws prescribe the Manner in which such Acts, Records and Proceedings shall be proved, and the Effect therof.

Section 2. The Citizens of each State shall be entitled to all Privileges and Immunities of Citizens in the several States.

A Person charged in any State with Treason, Felony, or other Crime, who shall flee from Justice, and be found in another State, shall on Demand of the executive Authority of the State from which he fled, be delivered up, to be removed to the State having Jurisdiction of the Crime. No person held to Service or Labour in one State, under the Laws thereof, escaping into another, shall, in Consequence of any Law or Regulation therein, be discharged from such Service or Labour, but shall be delivered up on Claim of the Party to whom such Service or Labour may be due.

Section 3. New States may be admitted by the Congress into this Union; but no new State shall be formed or erected within the Jurisdiction of any other State; nor any State be formed by the Junction of two or more States, or Parts of States, without the Consent of the Legislatures of the States concerned as well as of the Congress.

The Congress shall have Power to dispose of and make all needful Rules and Regulations respecting the Territory or other Property belonging to the United States; and nothing in this Constitution shall be so construed as to Prejudice any Claims of the United States, or of any particular State.

Section 4. The United States shall guarantee to every State in this Union a Republican Form of Government, and shall protect each of them against Invasion; and on Application of the Legislature, or of the Executive (when the Legislature cannot be convened) against domestic Violence.

Article V

The Congress, whenever two thirds of both Houses shall deem it necessary, shall propose Amendments to this Constitution, or, on the Application of the Legislatures of two thirds of the several States, shall call a Convention for proposing Amendments, which, in either Case, shall be valid to all Intents and Purposes, as Part of this Constitution, when ratified by the Legislatures of three fourths of the several States, or by Conventions in three fourths thereof, as the one or the other Mode of Ratification may be proposed by the Congress; Provided that no Amendment which may be made prior to the Year One thousand eight hundred and eight shall in any Manner affect the first and fourth Clauses in the Ninth Section of the first Article; and that no State, without its Consent, shall be deprived of its equal Suffrage in the Senate.

Article VI

All Debts contracted and Engagements entered into, before the Adoption of this Constitution, shall be as valid against the United States under this Constitution, as under the Confederation. This Constitution, and the Laws of the United States which shall be made in Pursuance thereof; and all Treaties made, or which shall be made, under the Authority of the United States, shall be the supreme Law of the Land; and the Judges in every State shall be bound thereby, any Thing in the Constitution or Laws of any State to the Contrary notwithstanding.

The Senators and Representatives before mentioned, and the Members of the several State Legislatures, and all executive and judicial Officers, both of the United States and of the several

States, shall be bound by Oath or Affirmation, to support this Constitution; but no religious Test shall ever be required as a Qualification to any Office or public Trust under the United States.

Article VII

The Ratification of the Conventions of nine States, shall be sufficient for the Establishment of this Constitution between the states so ratifying the Same

Bill of Rights

As provided in the First Ten Amendments to the Constitution of the United

Effective December 15, 1791

Articles In Addition To, And Amendment Of, The Constitution of the United States of America, proposed by Congress, and ratified by the Legislatures of the several States, pursuant to the fifth Article of the original Constitution

The conventions of a number of the States having at the time of their adopting the Constitution, expressed a desire, in order to prevent misconstruction or abuse of its powers, that further declaratory and restrictive clauses should be added: And as extending the ground of public confidence in the Government, will best insure the beneficient ends of its institution.

Amendment I

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

Amendment II

A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

Amendment III

No Soldier shall, in time of peace be quartered in any house, without the consent of the Owner, nor in time of war, but in a manner to be prescribed by law.

The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.

No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a Grand Jury, except in cases arising in the land or naval forces, or in the Militia, when in actual service in time of War or public danger; nor shall any person be subject for the same offence to be twice put in jeopardy of life or limb; nor shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself, nor be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use, without just

Amendment VI

In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury of the State and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, which district shall have been previously ascertained by law, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; to be confronted with the witnesses against him; to have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor, and to have the Assistance of Counsel for his defence.

Amendment VII

In Suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed twenty dollars, the right of trial by jury shall be preserved, and no fact tried by a jury, shall be otherwise reexamined in any Court of the United States, than according to the rules of the common law.

Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishment inflicted.

Amendment IX

The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people

The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.

THE CONSTITUTION PARTY

Advocating State Rights and State Citizenship

We, the founders of the Constitution Party, hold that our federal government has consistently violated the Constitution for the United States of America. The Founding Fathers designed the U.S. government to serve us - the people. It was not designed so that we the people would serve government. We no longer wish to see Americans dependent upon or enslaved by government. Generations of Republican and Democratic administrations have made it abundantly clear that they are incapable of managing the nation's affairs competently, justly or lawfully. The CP is dedicated to ensuring the unalienable right of every American to Life, Liberty, Property and the Pursuit of Happiness by defending the Constitution for the United States of America and making certain that it stays the law of the land.

The right to own one's life is a natural right. It requires the rights to freedom and property ownership in order to sustain that life. Therefore, the CP holds that no one has the right to dictate to anyone else how to live. It further maintains that no one holds a higher moral authority to compel anyone else to behave in a particular way. The CP maintains that each individual has the right to behave according to his or her self-determined moral principles, provided the pursuit of these principles causes no physical harm to any other person or his property. The CP believes that if there is no victim there is no crime. The CP believes that no entity, including a majority of voters or citizens, may take away or violate the rights of an individual.

Accordingly, the CP calls for a reordering of national priorities. We aim to restore the right of every individual American to be a sovereign critizen, as well as the provision that all 50 states be free from unlawful federal interference so they can self-govern. Our goal is to create a truly free country where all people will learn to be responsible for their own welfare. Upon achieving this goal, enterprise will flower, thereby creating an atmosphere of prosperity, abundance, tolerance

and compassion.

Therefore, the CP offers the following platform to ensure our rights and those of our children:

1. Under no circumstance does the federal government have the power to violate the Constitutionally guaranteed rights of an individual.

2. Under no circumstance does the federal government have the power to violate the sovereignty of the states as defined in the 10th Amendment

People who harm others are to be forcibly segregated from the rest of society by government. It is society, not the criminal, that should be shown leniency.

The CP supports full private property rights. We reject the idea that federal government may dictate use of private property or confiscate property without full and just compensation pursuant to the limits of the Constitution.

5. Each individual adult has the right to keep and bear arms, providing the owner has never been convicted of a violent crime involving the use of a weapon.

6. The CP advocates the maintenance of the strongest national defense force in the world. The CP does not advocate military interference in the affairs of other nations. The CP further believes that the U.S. should protect its sovereignty by maintaining full control over its own defense systems and not turning them over the United Nations.

7. The CP advocates full financial freedom. The CP believes that individuals have the right to keep all money or property they have lawfully earned, to provide for themselves and their families. The CP believes it is not government's business to know how much money you earn, where your money or property is kept, or to require you to keep records on its behalf. Accordingly, it believes that government has no right to use any of its agencies to intimidate people into revealing how much money they have or earn, with threats of jail terms and property seizures. Government has no right to force an individual to report how much money he or she deposits or withdraws from a bank. This stance requires the elimination of the Internal Revenue Service and the income tax code, the elimination of all gifl and estate taxes, as well as any other direct tax not authorized under the Constitution for the United States of America. To the extent revenue is needed to support the federal government, within the limits of the Constitution, excise taxes (i.e. a national sales tax) are authorized in Article 1, Section 8 of the Constitution.

The elimination of these unlawful taxes would cause business to skyrocket, create millions of jobs, and significantly reduce unemployment and welfare lines. It would also reduce crime. The CP calls for repeal of the 16th Amendment or formal recognition by the government that it was never ratified by the states and is therefore illegal.

8. The CP calls for the reinstitution of sound money, preferably a hard dollar backed by gold.

9. The CP insists upon the elimination of the budget deficit by a rigorous program of downsizing federal government and eliminating entitlement programs. The CP also calls for the elimination of burdensome interest payments on the national debt by ridding the American people of this debt once and for all. This stance requires the elimination of the Internal Revenue Service and the inc

10. The CP advocates the elimination of entitlement programs. Just as no individual has the right to steal from you, the government has no right to steal from you on behalf of other individuals, that is, to redistribute your wealth. The money you carn belongs to you and no one else. How can you properly support yourself and your family while you are constantly being robbed? The price of personal freedom is individual responsibility. Consequently, it is not government's job to "save" people from poor choices, calamities, or the vicissitudes of life. At the same time, the CP encourages everyone, individuals and private institutions alike, in the strongest possible terms, to give to the charities of their choice, to care for the homeless, the helpless, and the needy. Charity is traditionally the work of religious organizations, individuals, private institutions and foundations. In contrast, giveaway programs run by the federal government rob individuals of the ability and desire to be charitable.

The CP further believes that the elimination of giveaway programs will greatly alleviate the nation's immigration problem. The CP believes in phasing out the Social Security program after current obligations to the elderly are met. We believe retirement programs are best handled by the private sector.

It. The CP believes that federal government has no lawful or moral authority in health care. The CP believes that government involvement in health care will adversely affect the health of the majority of Americans.

The CP believes that federal government ha no right to limit our choice of doctors, or medicines they prescribe, whether they be "alternative" or American Medical Association certified. Government also has no right to dictate what vitamins ought to be available.

The CP opposes the proposed national health card. This card will ultimately be used as nothing less than a national tracking device that will result in the further loss of personal freedom.

12. The CP endorses full economic freedom. The CP believes that government should not set prices, set quotas, or create laws concerning hiring, firing, rents, wages, unionization, or any aspect of non-coercive private commercial behavior. Economic freedom would be a boon to both small and large business.

business.

13. Government does not have the right to legislate morality. Adult consensual behavior ("victimless crimes") are a matter of individual adult morality and not a matter of lawful statute. The traditional organizations for discussion and persuasion regarding moral issues include churches, synagogues, youth clubs, chambers of commerce, and other local social organizations.

local social organizations.

14. The CP advocates a strong local police presence for violent crime. By eliminating laws against victimless crimes, police will be able to focus on violent crimes, making police more effective and public safety a reality. The prison system will then have ample space to house violent criminals for the full course of their prison terms. The streets will be safe, the country's legal and prison systems will unclog, and vast amounts of money that add to the budget deficit will be saved.

Nevertheless, a government that must break the law in order to enforce the law is not a government worth having. Therefore, law enforcement officers and agencies must be above reproach with regard to due process of law, personal privacy, freedom from unreasonable search and seizures, and all the other fundamental constitutional guarantees. The CP believes that any government agent or employee who does not abide by, or who violates the Constitution should facermment agent or employee who does not abide by, or who violates the Constitution should face

seizures, and an the other fundamental constitutional guarantees. The CF betteves that any government agent or employee who does not abide by, or who violates the Constitution should face mandatory criminal penalties.

15. The CF believes that all judges must be directed to inform every jury of its lawful soveriginty under the Constitution in that it may find any defendant not guilty if it judges the law, even law upheld by the Supreme Court, to be defective, unwarranted, unconstitutional, or wrongly

law upheld by the Supreme Court, to be defective, unwarranted, unconstitutional, or wrongly applied.

The CP believes that we are at the beginning of a movement, a movement toward individual freedoms, as our Forefathers planned. We believe that people have had enough of the taxes and the intimidating tactics of an out-of-control, unaccountable government which has lost sight of its role as our servant. We believe it is time again to make the government accountable to us - the American people - and to restore our personal freedoms which have been slowly but systematically taken from us. We believe that if we as a people fail to act, the course on which the ship of state is currently set is clear: an accelerating bankrupt socialist police state.

To all Americans who want to keep their rights: whether it be the right to speak your mind, the right to keep the money you earn, the right to use your property as you wish, the right to bear arms for the defense of your family from any threat including government, the right to choose a doctor or the medicine of your choice, the right to end your life, or the right to begin a life these are your personal choices, not the governments.

To all Americans who feel alienated from the politics of our system and are tirred of being treated like juveniles: we understand your frustration and your desire for change. Come join us! No matter who you are or what you do, come join us. It's not whether you are on the left or the right, liberal or conservative, it's your individual rights that matter.

By law, roman magistrates could bring armies into Italy only by permission of the Senate. By marching his legions across the Rubicon in 49 B.C., Julius Caesar committed himself to a showdown with Rome itself.

Rome was the most powerful city in the world. The Romans had conquered all the countries on the north side of the Mediterranean Sea and most of those on the south side. They also occupied the islands of the sea and all that part of Asia that now belongs to Turkey.

Julius Caesar had become the hem of Rome. He had led a large army into Gaul, that part of Furope which today includes France, Belgium and Switzerland, and turned it into a Roman province. He had crossed the Rhine and subdued a part of Germany. Caesar's army even went into Britain, a wild and remote country to the Romans, and established colonies there.

For nine years Caesar and his army had served Rome loyally and well. But Caesar had many neemies a home, People who feared his ambitions and enviced his accomplishments, people who cringed everytime they heard Caesar called a great hero.






